

Can You Pray Lord Come Quickly?

To be able to pray "Lord, come quickly" indicates that we believe our soul is right before God. It means we are ready for the Lord's return. Which of us can say we have prayed this prayer?

We sometimes words this sentiment when we are so tired and frustrated with the problems of this life that we just wish it was all over and we could move on to something better. That's a good sentiment, but are we ready to move on, even if it is to something worse?

Sometimes we pray this thinking we are right before God, but have we verified that fact based upon what the Scriptures teach or are we satisfied with a warm feeling of security in our heart? Jesus says we will be judged by His words (John 12:48), so when we consider His words, are we ready?

Sometimes this prayer is heard in a public setting, and it is the type of thing that stirs us up and makes us think spiritual thoughts. We must be careful that we are not praying to be seen of men (Matthew 6:5) for this is not pleasing in God's sight, and ultimately we will not be heard by God, because "they have their reward" (Matthew 6:5). We must be certain about what we pray for. The prayer of a righteous man availeth much, therefore Jesus may just come quickly. We may voice the prayer and not mean it - but other faithful men may hear it and commend it to God as their desire.

The true question is, have we said "Lord, come quickly" in our private prayers? If not, it may be because we do not feel ready.
