Can You Pray Lord Come Quickly?

To be able to pray Lord, come quickly indicates that we believe our soul is right before God. It means we are ready for the Lord's return. Which of us can say we have prayed this prayer?

We sometimes words this sentiment when we are so tired and frustrated with the problems of this life that we just wish it was all over and we could move on to something better. That's a good sentiment, but are we ready to move on, even if it is to something worse?

Sometimes we pray this thinking we are right before God, but have we verified that fact based upon what the Scriptures teach or are we satisfied with a warm feeling of security in our heart? Jesus says we will be judged by His words (John 12:48), so when we consider His words, are we ready?

Sometimes this prayer is heard in a public setting, and it is the type of thing that stirs us up and makes us think spiritual thoughts. We must be careful that we are not praying to be seen of men (Matthew 6:5) for this is not pleasing in God's sight, and ultimately we will not be heard by God, because they have their reward (Matthew 6:5). We must be certain about what we pray for. The prayer of a righteous man availeth much, therefore Jesus may just come quickly. We may voice the prayer and not mean it - but other faithful men may hear it and commend it to God as their desire.

The true question is, have we said Lord, come quickly in our private prayers? If not, it may be because we do not feel ready.

Do You Want To Be A Good Student Of The Bible?

Here is what it will take in order for this to come to pass:

1. A Searching Heart. Some subjects must be studied and searched out. Much effort and diligence is required. Don't be afraid to spend a little time in the book. (John 5:39; Proverbs 12:27; 2 Timothy 2:15)

2. A Deep and Abiding Desire to Know the Truth. Truth can be known. Jesus tells us it can. But I have to want to learn and know the truth. The speaks of our need to hunger for the milk and meat of the word. (John 8:32; Ephesians 5:17; Psalm 119:9-11, 103; Acts 17:11; 1 Peter 2:2)

3. A Firm Belief in the Inspiration of the Greatest Book in the World. Look at 2 Timothy 3:16-17. It is inspired and it is profitable for doctrine, reproof, correction, and training in righteousness.

4. A Willingness to Accept the Truth. Yes, it takes an open book, but also an open mind. There must be a willingness to accept and apply the truth to our life - even if it is different than what we thought. (1 Kings 8:18; Psalm 49:4)

5. A Willingness to Change. I know it isn't always easy, but it can be done, and you can do it. (Psalm 119:04; Proverbs 22:22)
